

LOCAL TECHNICAL AMENDMENT

FLORIDA BUILDING CODE 5th Edition (2014) - RESIDENTIAL

AMEND EXISTING SECTION

P3003.3.2 Solvent cementing. Joint surfaces shall be clean and free from moisture. Solvent cement that conforms to ASTM D 2235 or CSA B181.1 shall be applied to all joint surfaces. The joint shall be made while the cement is wet. Joints shall be made in accordance with ASTM D 2235, ASTM D 2661, ASTM F 628 or CSA B181.1. Solvent-cement joints shall be permitted above or below ground.

Exception: Clear Primer conforming to ASTM F 656 may be used on any exposed PVC pipe or fittings on trim/finish work.

Local Conditions and Need: This amendment allows the use of clear primer instead of purple primer when used on exposed PVC pipe or fittings on trim/finish work.

Fiscal Impact Statement: There is no cost impact associated with this amendment.

Effective Date: Effective date of Florida Building Code 5th Edition (2014) - Residential.
